CAN'T AFFORD TO MISS OUT ON TALENT?

The On-The-Job Training (OJT) program is a federally funded hiring incentive with a proven track record designed to assist unemployed workers in securing full-time employment. If your company hires an eligible recipient(s) and agrees to train them, you could be eligible to receive reimbursement of up to 50% of gross wages during the contract period.

Employer Benefits:

- Reduce the cost of hiring and training new employees
- Pre-screen applicants for your position - you decide who to hire
- Receive a partial wage reimbursement during the pre-determined training period
- Observe and train an employee before hiring

General Requirements:

- Trainees must meet eligibility requirements
- Trainee is hired as an employee of the company
- OJT agreement must be approved before trainees begin to work
