



# OCCUPATIONAL TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES



## DO YOU NEED TRAINING — BUT AREN'T SURE YOU CAN AFFORD IT?

You may be eligible for tuition assistance to help cover the cost of education and training. Occupational or skills-enhancement training may include technical and college training programs. Speak to a career counselor to determine if you qualify for these programs.

### Workforce funds for training:

- **WIOA Grant / Individual Training Account (ITA):** Individuals needing to upgrade their skills or obtain required certification to secure and maintain employment in an in-demand occupation may be eligible for funding through the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA).
- **Unemployment Tuition Waiver:** Eligible unemployed individuals can enroll, tuition-free, in courses at public colleges and universities in New Jersey when seats are available.
- **Division of Vocational Rehabilitation Services (DVRS):** Eligible work-ready individuals that have a documented disability, substantial impediment to employment, and economic hardship may be eligible for funding for education and training through DVRS.
